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What we offer:



CASE MANAGEMENT includes information and referrals; benefits and entitlements assistance; care coordination; and client advocacy

CAREGIVING SUPPORT includes support groups; self-care, educational and supportive events; and referrals for respite and LGBT-affirmative long-term care

FRIENDLY VISITING provides socialization and support through volunteers to homebound older adults who want to remain connected to the LGBT community

SUPPORT GROUPS for HIV+ individuals, cancer survivors, veterans, and more

SAGEVETS assists with VA benefit eligibility; legal advice regarding discharge status upgrades; and “know your rights” assistance for LGBT veterans age 50+

SAGEPOSITIVE encompasses a range of programs for LGBT people age 50+ living with HIV, as well as testing and educational events

E-LINC (Elder LGBT Interprofessional Collaborative Care) Program helps to support the health and wellness of older adults with help from our partners at Columbia University School of Nursing

BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT includes individual counseling sessions and eight-week small group gatherings for those facing grief from profound loss



SAGE's Care Management department is located at 305 Seventh Avenue, 15th Floor, New York, NY 10001. All services require an initial intake appointment. Please call 212-741-2247 and ask for the care manager on duty.

Intake and Care Management services are also offered through SAGE Centers in the Bronx, Brooklyn, Harlem, Midtown and Staten Island.
