

Program Intern

Summary:

The Brooklyn Community Pride Center is seeking a part-time, temporary intern for an eight-week placement at 1460 Broadway, NYC, 8nd floor. The intern reports to the Dianeldis Dislathe, Youth Program Manager.

The Fearless Flyers is a 10-week training program for New York City youth ages 16-24 that includes safety training in partnership with BikeNY and the NYC DOT. The program empowers young adults to build self-confidence, leadership and cycling skills. Each participant is provided a bike and helmet for the Saturday morning training rides. Training rides start at 10 miles and gradually increase to finish with a 35-mile ride. Graduates who successfully complete the training earn their own bike, helmet and lock.
